The arrangement with the company or organization may extend beyond the windows on the mutual arrangement between the student and the employer. Work done beyond the module window does not count towards the module.</p>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Modules may not be taken in the final year, or used to delay the final year.</li> <li>● Variable start/end date for internships, but all work for the modules should be completed within the module window (see below).</li> <li>● Students will need a Workplace Supervisor (from company or organization) and Academic Advisor (from NUS)</li> <li>● Student must have completed at least 60MC before they can enroll in the module.</li> <li>● Students will submit a written report to be reviewed by the Academic Advisor, with the endorsement of the Workplace Supervisor.</li> <li>● The final grade given by the Academic Advisor on the basis of the written report and Workplace Supervisor Feedback.</li> </ul>
